RE: Lowestoft Flood Risk Management Project – Tidal Walls – Hamilton Road Sheet Piling Works

Dear Sir/Madam,

The next phase of the Lowestoft Flood Risk Management Project involves installing some sheet piles on Hamilton Road. These works will take place from 2nd June 2021 until 9th June 2021 between the hours of 7:30am and 5pm.

The sheet piling may result in some noise and disturbance. We shall undertake all reasonable measures to minimize the noise and disruption from the works, and when not in use, all plant and machinery will be turned off. We apologise for the inconvenience these works may cause.

The Lowestoft Flood Risk Management Project, when completed, will provide protection from flooding to over 1500 homes and 800 businesses. The Town currently has no formal flood defences to prevent flooding from the sea. These works are a vital step in the development of the flood walls and will also help to minimise disruption to traffic through the Town during the day.
