RE: Lowestoft Flood Risk Management Project – Tidal Walls – Waveney Road Night Closure, June 2021

Dear Sir/Madam,

The next phase of the Lowestoft Flood Risk Management Project involves some night works on Waveney Road. These works will take place on Waveney Road on 7th, 8th and 9th June between the hours of 8pm and 6am.

The works will involve reinstating the footpath and installing a mass barrier. Due to the nature of these works, we need to undertake them under a full road closure. Waveney Road will therefore be closed on the above dates from 8pm to 6am.

These works may result in some noise and disturbance. We shall undertake all reasonable measures to minimise the noise and disruption from the works, and when not in use, all plant and machinery will be turned off. We apologise for the inconvenience these night works may cause.

The Lowestoft Flood Risk Management Project, when completed, will provide protection from flooding to over 1500 homes and 800 businesses. The Town currently has no formal flood defences to prevent flooding from the sea. These overnight works are a vital step in the development of the flood walls and will also help to minimise disruption to traffic through the Town during the day.
