RE: Lowestoft Flood Risk Management Project – Tidal Walls – Gas Main Disconnection Works, Hamilton Road

Dear Sir/Madam,

The next phase of the Lowestoft Flood Risk Management Project involves disconnecting two disused gas mains on Hamilton Road. These are outlined on the drawing below in red.

The works will take place on 29th August 2021 between the hours of 7:30am and 5pm.



We require traffic management to be installed so we can undertake these works safely. We apologise for any inconvenience caused. Your access will not be impeded by these works and there will be a traffic marshal on site to aid in any vehicle movements in this area.

The Lowestoft Flood Risk Management Project, when completed, will provide protection from flooding to over 1500 homes and 800 businesses. The Town currently has no formal flood defences to prevent flooding from the sea. These overnight works are a vital step in the development of the flood walls and will also help to minimise disruption to traffic through the Town during the day.
