RE: Lowestoft Flood Risk Management Project – Tidal Walls – Waveney Road Night Works, April 2022

Dear Sir/Madam,

The next phase of the Lowestoft Flood Risk Management Project involves installing some temporary traffic management on Waveney Road. Due to the nature of these works, we need to undertake these at night. To enable us to do these works quickly and safely we will need to close Waveney Road.

Waveney Road will be closed on Monday 4th April 2022 between the hours of 8pm and 6am to install a temporary barrier on the footpath to enable construction of the tidal flood walls to continue. The footpath closure and diversion will be clearly signed.


The Lowestoft Flood Risk Management Project is critical to the Town. When completed, it will provide protection from flooding to over 1500 homes and 800 businesses. Lowestoft currently has no formal flood defences to prevent flooding from the sea. These overnight works are a vital step in the development of the flood walls and will also help to minimise disruption to traffic through the Town during the day.
